

THE MESSAGE OF THE WINDOW

At the highest point of the window there is the figure of the lamb, with the caption, "Behold the Lamb of God". This sets forth the purpose of the window, which is to highlight some of the events in the last days of the Christ. We see Jesus in the Triumphal Entry into Jerusalem, when He is hailed as the "Son of David", the Messiah who came to fulfill the Kingdom. We are reminded of the centrality of Holy Communion, as the Last Supper is depicted in the scene on the lower right.

The central portion of the window shows Jesus in the Garden of Gethsemane shortly before He was arrested. The Disciples could not remain awake to watch and pray. Jesus is very much alone. And the burden of the cross weighs heavily upon Him. But, over and above the sorrow and pathos of the scene there comes the message of Jesus' commitment to the doing of the will of God. In this is His glory, and in this, we who follow the Christ, rejoice.
