IN TRIBUTE

Elgin G. Turnbull was born on February 5th, 1903 in Sarnia, Ontario. His early education was in Lambton and Sarnia Schools. He received his B.A. and B.D. degrees from Queen's University. In 1958 Queen's Theological College conferred upon him the D.D. degree (honoris causa). After his ordination by the London Conference in 1932 he served in Deer Park Church, Toronto; Wesley Church, Fort William; Knox Church, Edmonton; and Central Church, Sault Ste. Marie, before coming to Calvary in 1951. During his ministry Dr. Turnbull was on four occasions the Chairman of Presbytery, and in 1955 was elected President of the London Conference. He was a member of the Home Mission Board of our Church, served on many Presbytery Committees, and on the London Conference Committee studying union with the Anglican Church.
